

### Rent Eats First

We have all heard by now that housing costs in the Charlotte area are skyrocketing. Did you also know that the number of neighbors facing food insecurity is also critically high? In plain and simple terms, rent gets priority before groceries are purchased, and children and families are going hungry in our community. Our partners at Loaves and Fishes/Friendship Trays report that donations of food and financial gifts haven't kept up with this unprecedented demand, so we "need a crisis-level response from the community."

Our Loaves and Fishes pantry shelves, as well as the pantry at Westerly Hills Academy, are in need of restocking on a continual basis. We need donations of fresh items each week as well as nonperishable goods to give to our neighbors who shop in our church pantry and the families who stop by the Westerly Hills Academy pantry every week. Your help is needed in three ways:

1. Make a habit of bringing donations of nonperishable food to church each quarter on Communion Sunday as part of your spiritual practice of coming to the Lord's Table.
2. Sign up to donate fresh produce and/or perishable food to our pantries on a specific week through our Sign Up Genius: [fpc.tiny.us/fooddonations](http://fpc.tiny.us/fooddonations)
3. Volunteer to assist neighbors who shop in our church pantry on Wednesdays, Fridays, and, starting in October, Saturdays. Also, grab a friend and run a Wednesday delivery route to our 28208 neighbors to deliver groceries directly to the doorsteps of families in need through our Home Delivery program, also starting in October.
