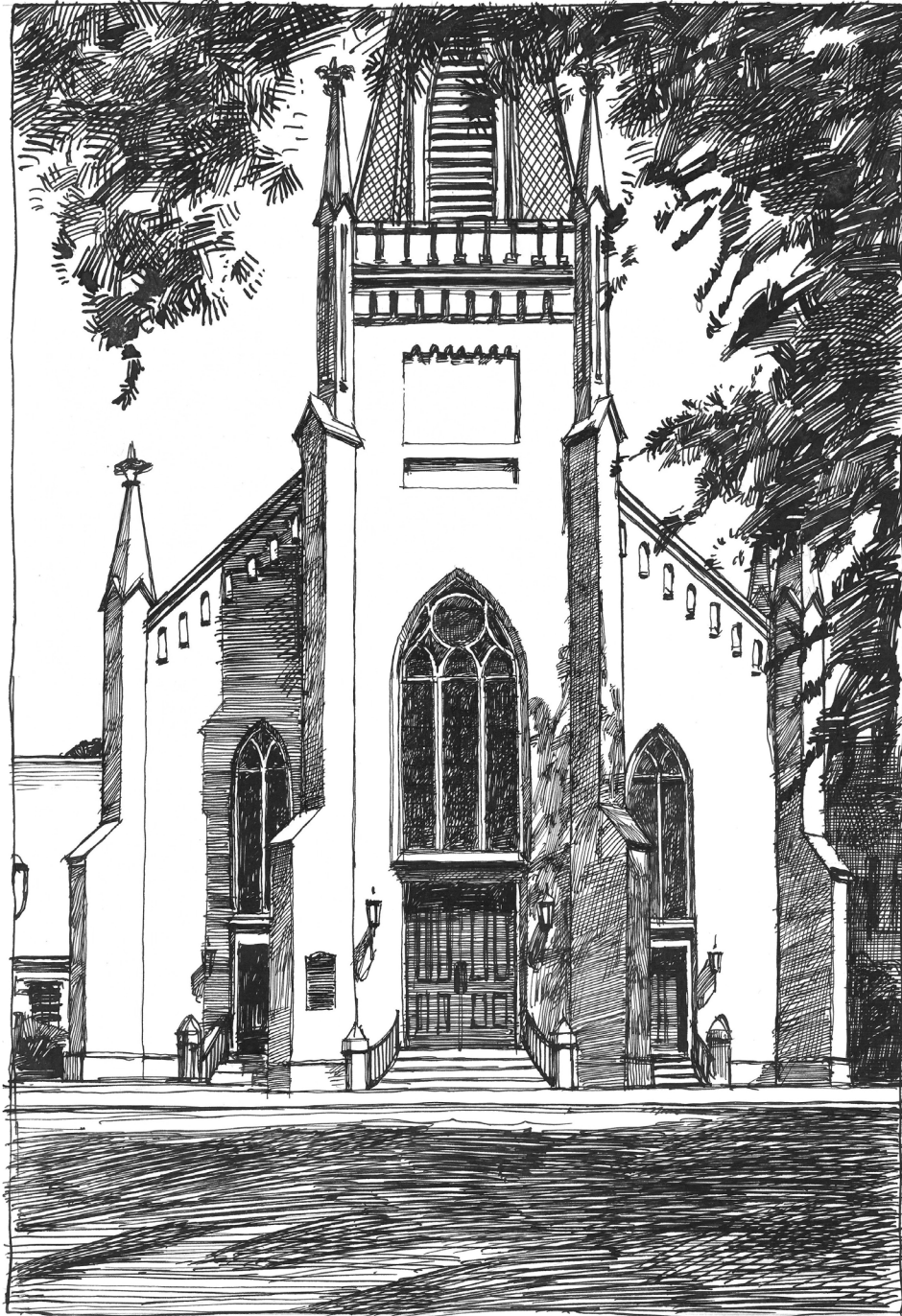


First Presbyterian Church
